

# Prepare Your Household Safety Plan

1. Meet with your entire family and discuss what each member needs to do to remain safe.
2. Determine how and where you would transport family pets and animals. Make sure your animals are easily identified and plan for food and water. Remember the Red Cross shelters do not accept pets. Contact the North Valley Animal Disaster Group for assistance. 530/895-0000
3. Determine an out-of-area central point of contact; this can be a physical location and/or a phone number.
4. Designate a local contact for care of children and pets.
5. Review the Emergency Travel Routes and Public Assembly Points. Make sure everyone becomes familiar with each location and would be able to find them if need be.
6. **Complete your personalized Household Safety Plan (below).**
7. Set up practice drills with your family before fire season starts.
8. Update your Household Safety Plan annually or as needed.
